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Opening and Attendance
- Meeting called to order at 7:09 p.m.; Board members were introduced.
  - Board members present: Cathy Johnson, Orville Eid, Zulma Tedesco, John Madison, Ryan Stout, Steven Tucker, and Carmen Woodward. Absent: Caron McGhee, Mike Stegmeir, and Adam Fratini.
  - Officers: Jeff Tucker, President; Dan Cronin, Vice President; Gary Smart, Treasurer; Randy Christman, Secretary.
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Board and Officer Changes
- Jay Turney volunteered to serve on the Board.
  - Gary Smart resigned as Treasurer but stated that he wished to remain on the Board. John Madison volunteered for Treasurer and was elected by the members.
  - Randy Christman resigned as Secretary. Ryan Stout volunteered for Secretary and was elected by the members.
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League Business and Budget
- The February 19, 2026 meeting minutes were approved.
  - Bank balances as of June 1, 2026: Checking, \$2,599.70; Savings, \$953.10.
  - Dart awards: 180 and nine-count pins cost \$2.50 each; 100 of each are needed. Awards include championship trophies for teams and players, runner-up trophies for teams only, and limited continuation of mugs for first-time 180s, nine-counts, high-ons, and high-outs.
  - Projected Spring 2026 season award costs: approximately \$1,700.
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Fall 2026 Schedule and Branding
- Awards and League Sign-Up Night: Saturday, August 1, 2026. Sign-up at 5:00 p.m., awards at 6:00 p.m., and tournament at 7:00 p.m.
  - Captain's Meeting and Tournament: Thursday, August 6, 2026. Season start: Thursday, August 13, 2026.
  - The updated logo was well received and adopted, subject to a minor adjustment.
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AFDA Tournament
- The team placed third.
  - Sponsorships should be pursued for shirts and other costs, with sponsor recognition on shirts, the website, Facebook, and other promotional materials.
  - Potential player contribution: \$25 per player toward shirt costs.
  - Eligibility proposal: play three nights in one season; full-time players preferred.
  - Selection proposal: \$5 round-robin tournament, with the team selected in January to allow practice time.
  - Eligibility rules need to be documented; placement in the bylaws or another document remains to be determined.
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Wild West Shootout
- The event is ADO sanctioned, and Toso's will serve as the sponsor bar.
  - Concern was raised about league responsibility for costs if the event operates at a loss.
  - Sponsorship opportunities and event details remain under investigation.
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Bylaws, Tablets, and DartConnect
- No league bylaw updates were presented.
  - The league owns eight tablets; most are considered too old, so the home team will need to provide tablets.
  - The league will continue using DartConnect. Tablet training was also discussed.
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Open Discussion and Adjournment
- The Patriots Tournament on July 18 and Mason's were discussed.
  - The meeting adjourned at 9:00 p.m.
