3 State of the League Address

The Board reviewed the current state of the Arizona Darts League, league growth, and future objectives.

Discussion Highlights

- League participation for the Fall 2026 season stands at 18 teams across 3 divisions.
- New league leadership continues to focus on league growth and retention, improved member communication, and expansion of the league's digital presence.
- Feedback and concerns raised during previous meetings were reviewed and addressed.
- The Board discussed confusion surrounding the 2026 Wild West Tournament. Due to a breakdown in communication between the ADL President and Bull Shooters ownership, the tournament will not be held at Bull Shooters in 2026 and will instead be held at Toso's. Subsequent discussions were held with the understanding that the Wild West Tournament will return to Bull Shooters in 2027.

4 Alternate League Ideas

The Board discussed opportunities to expand league offerings and increase player participation.

Topics Discussed

- Interest in establishing a Women's Singles and/or Women's Doubles league.
- Additional alternate league formats.
- The Board discussed the potential introduction of a Mixed Singles and/or Doubles league. Tuesday and Wednesday were identified as potential league nights for consideration.

No formal motions were made regarding alternate league formats.

5 Upcoming Fall 2026 Season

Season Information

- Fall 2026 season: 18 teams across 3 divisions.
- Playoff format: The top four teams from each division will advance to the playoffs.
- Captains meeting: August 6, 2026.
- Season start date: August 13, 2026.

- Player fees: \$40.00 per player; after Week 1, fees increase to \$45.00 per player.
- Sponsor fee: \$50.00 per team.

Players were reminded that fees may be paid to Treasurer John Madison via Venmo, cash, or check payable to ADL.
